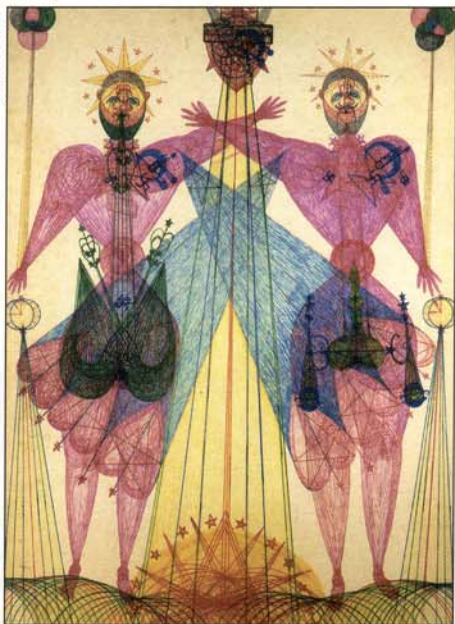

La Maison en Vaisselle Cassée (The House of Broken Crockery), also known as La Maison aux Papillons, situated south of Rouen, recently re-opened to the public. Robert Vasseur began to cover his house and garden in crockery, shells and stones in 1952, continuing until just 2 years before his death in 2002 aged 94.
